Spring is in the air and for KPB that means only one thing "Great American Cleanup." April is proclaimed as GAC month. This year GAC will include several different opportunities for participation:

- Adopt A Road Program Volunteers will pickup their assigned roadways during April
- April 18th, the shredder is back from 9:00 – 12 noon. Residents can shred documents for only \$4.00 a banker's box.
- Tire amnesty for April. The recycle centers will take 4 passenger tires, off the rims, no charge at Cove Road, and Camp Road. Additional tires will be \$3.00 each.
- The Recycle Center will also accept auto, boat and motorcycle batteries; glass; aluminum; cardboard; paper; used motor oil; metal, and used appliances (Fees to remove Freon: small refrigerator-\$6, large refrigerator-\$12, A/C unit-\$12)
- Paint may be recycled if you have a 1/2 can or more at the Communality Thrift Store. You CAN NOT put paint in the trash, unless it is a solid mass. For small amounts of paint you may use sand, Kitty litter, oil dry or you can purchase a drying agent at your local hardware store.
- City of Jasper will have weekly cleanups during the month of April.
- Town of Talking Rock: April 18th trash service will pick up a maximum of 3 large items.
