(2) "Homestead" means homestead as defined and qualified in Code Section 48-5-40 of

the O.C.G.A., as amended, with the additional qualification that it shall include not more than five

- of the year in which application for the exemption under the Act is made.

The exemption shall be claimed and returned as provided in Code Section 48-5-50.1, as amended, of the O.C.G.A. The exemption shall be automatically renewed from year to year as long as the owner occupies the residence as a homestead. After a person has filed the proper affidavit

necessary to determine the initial and continuing eligibility of the owner for the exemption.
